Creation of Common Research and Technology Development Hubs (CRTDHs)

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR) operates a programme aimed at setting up of **Common Research and Technology Development Hubs (CRTDHs)** to encourage research and technology development activities by Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Partial financial support would be provided as grant-in-aid for procuring R&D equipment and accessories and setting up of pilot plant facilities for prototype development to facilitate MSMEs to undertake R&D and technology development for new/improved products and processes including testing and analysis.

Proposals are invited from National laboratories, Public funded bodies or Institutions having a distinct legal entity (as per Rule 228 of GFR 2017) for setting up of CRTDHs in the following five sectors:

- 1. Electronics/Renewable Energy**
- 2. Affordable Health**
- 3. Environmental Interventions**
- 4. Low Cost Machining**
- 5. New Materials / Chemical Process**
